(Alden, NY) – The Lancaster Family YMCA is pleased to be able to offer School Age Child Care (SACC) programs at Alden Primary and Alden Intermediate Schools for the 2009-2010 school year. Parents with children ages 5 – 12 years old are encouraged to register their child for this program which is facilitated in a safe, well supervised, fun, and nurturing environment. School Age Child Care offers learning centers, arts and crafts, service learning projects, character development time, games, outdoor play (weather permitting) a snack and so much more.

Programming begins at 6:45am and lasts until the start of the school day while the PM program runs from the end of the school day until 6:00 pm. The YMCA even offers half day programs for children when there are early dismissal days. Parents are encouraged to register monthly so as to secure their spot in the program. Financial assistance is also available for those who qualify so that you may still receive the quality care for your child that you need.
