School Age Child Care Registration Underway at Ellicott-Masten YMCA

(Buffalo, NY) - The Ellicott-Masten Family YMCA (585 William Street, Buffalo) is now accepting applications for School Age Child Care (SACC). The program includes free tutoring, swimming, arts & crafts, community service projects, gym games, 40 developmental asset programming, and homework assistance.

The program runs on normal school days, Monday-Friday, but also offers full day vacation day programming on school holidays. Fees are on a sliding scale and are based on the household income and number of residence. The YMCA will also be holding an **open house** for adults and families the week of **September 14th through the 19th**. During this week, anyone who joins the YMCA will not be charged the joining fee (**up to a \$50 savings!**) This offer is only available during this week.
