YMCA CAMP WEONA

Suggested "What to Bring List" for campers for (2) two weeks of camp (adjust for 7 day camp as needed)

CLOTHING:

- 10 pairs of shorts
- 12 t-shirts
- 15 pairs of underwear
- 15 pairs of socks
- 4 pairs of old durable jeans
- 2 long sleeve shirts
- 2 sweatshirts
- 1 pairs of warm pajamas

- 1 pair of athletic shoes
- Poncho or Raincoat (When it is a light rain we continue programs)
- Croc Style for pool and showers (please no open toed shoes or sandals)
- *Any prescription medication (which must be turned into the Camp Staff at registration)

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- Toothbrush
- Lip Balm
- Toothpaste
- Shower towel & swim towel
- Soap (in container)
- Hairbrush
- Shampoo & rinse (plastic bottles)

- Hair accessories
- Deodorant
- Female Hygiene products
- Shower Shoes/CROC style (again no open toe)
- A Shower Caddy to carry items to showers
- Horseback participants must have shoes with a heel such as boots

OTHER ITEMS:

- Sleeping bag
- Flashlight
- Pillow
- Laundry Bag
- 2 sheets (twin size)
- 2 pillow cases
- 5 towels
- 4 wash cloths

FUN THINGS: (optional)

- Musical instruments (guitars)
- Camp chair
- Books/Magazines/Cards
- Writing paper/pens/pencil/envelopes & stamps
- Camera (Disposable)
- Fishing Gear
- Baseball glove or mitt

SUMMER THINGS

- Bathing Suit
- Sunscreen
- Bug Repellent
- A fun costume or Hawaiian Shirt or 80s clothes
- Hat

MUST BRING: (these are absolutes)

- Water Bottle or Camelback style water container**
- Day pack/backpack**
- 2 pairs of sneakers**

DO NOT BRING:

XX Open Toed Shoes/sandals
XX Pets (Not even for check in/out)
XX Firecracker/Safe and Sane Fireworks
XX MP3 PLAYERS, STEREOs & CELL PHONES
XX Firearms
XX Radios/TVs

XX Illegal substances
XX Expensive/Irreplaceable items
XX Illegal Drugs
XX Alcohol
XX Weapons/Knives
XX Electronic Devices (Beepers/Gameboys/Etc.)

Remember to clearly mark all items with campers name, initials, or distinctive emblem. Please make sure suitcases and bags are closed and tied securely. All items on DO NOT BRING list will be confiscated and returned to parents upon departure from camp and may result in the immediate dismissal from camp at the parent/guardian expense. The YMCA reserves the right to search all luggage on YMCA property.
